Thank you for agreeing to be part of Rotherham Pride 2021. The team and I are very excited to have you on-board and we are all looking forward to what is going to be another very special Pride event.

In this pack you will find all the information you need including essential information and code of conduct.

Your performance will be showcased on our website: www.rotherhampride.co.uk on Saturday 10th July 2021 and it will remain on our website thereafter for all to enjoy. Rotherham Pride have the right to take down content at any time. Performances will be promoted through our social media platforms, encouraging viewers to watch via the website.

Unfortunately, if you submit content late we cannot guarantee that you will be able to appear as part of our virtual line-up. In such circumstances we reserve the right to withhold full payment.

We do appreciate that sometimes things do go wrong so please do contact us in plenty of time if there is a problem. If you need to cancel your performance please give us at least three weeks' notice, so that we can try and find an alternative act.

Once you have completed the Acts Booking Form, read & confirmed that you have read our GDPR Statement & Minimum Standards Guide, you will be sent an upload link, where you will be able to upload your performance directly to our partners, NeonTech.

NeonTech have provided the **Minimum Standards Guide** to ensure that all content is of good quality. Rotherham Pride reserves the right to discount content if the guide has not been followed and content is of poor visual quality, inaudible or otherwise unsuitable.

Payments will be made the week following Pride Day, Saturday 10th July 2021. Ideally payments will be made via PayPal. Alternatively a cheque will be posted. **It is your responsibility to ensure prior to the day we have the correct payment details.**

Here at Rotherham Pride we pride ourselves in delivering a family fun event that is open to all. Due to issues in previous years we have decided to bring in a code of conduct that we ask all our volunteers, performers and stall holders to abide by (it's worked so far!).

Code of Conduct for performers:

- Rotherham Pride is a family event, open to all regardless of their age, gender, sexuality, gender identity, religion or cultural background. Please respect this and be mindful of not causing offence to others.
- If you are an After Party act & content is aimed at those aged 18+, please clearly state this & ensure that content is respectful, appropriate & in-line with Rotherham Pride's values.
- If you are using Copyrighted material within your performance, please make this clear to us; some platforms will make copyrighted performances inaudible or remove them completely.
- You must seek the correct permissions to use the work of others.

- Rotherham Pride is run by a team of volunteers, so please remain respectful to them. Any incidences of abusive or disrespectful behaviour may result in the termination of your contract to perform.
- Please note any termination of contract will also lead to cancellation of payment.
